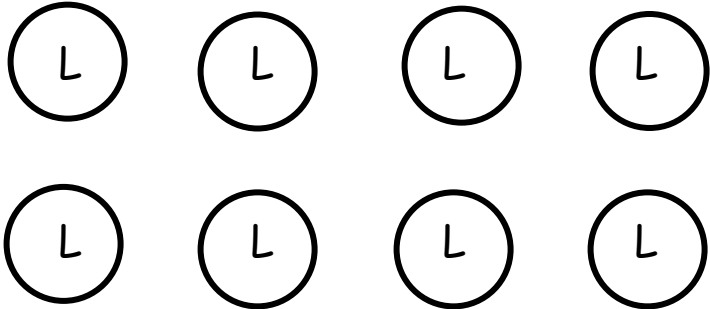









**Auditory Bombardment**

Word	Symbol	Sentence
<b>lamb</b>		The lamb is in the grass.
<b>leaf</b>		The leaf fell off the tree.
<b>lamp</b>		I can turn on the lamp.
<b>ladder</b>		I can climb the ladder.
<b>log</b>		The log is on the ground.
<b>lips</b>		My lips are pink.
<b>lollipop</b>		I like to eat a lollipop.

Read the bombardment list out loud to your child. DO NOT ASK THEM TO REPEAT THE WORDS. Ask them to touch and say the sound of the letter in the circle, then get them to name the picture of the words below. Say the word and have them repeat if they do not know the name. Read the sentence out loud to your child and have them repeat using a good "target" sound or ask them to read the sentences to you. PRACTICE DAILY!
